Service Check List Details

What will be Checked on the Engine Pre-Run and Fluid Level Check?

Start Up Check List

- () Start Engines and bring them to operating temperature
- () Check all filters, motor and bilge area for any leaks
- () Check all gauges and make sure they are operating correctly
- () Make sure all electronics are powering up and operating
- () Make sure all rocker switches/buttons on dash are working
- () Check all navigation lights
- () Check and make sure horn works
- () Make sure boat is shifting into gear smoothly

Pre-Start Check List

- () Check oil levels
- () Check coolant levels
- () Check drive lube
- () Check voltage meter
- () Empty all sea strainers and check cut off valves
- () Check all bilge pumps and floats

Generator/Shorepower Checklist

- () Check oil level
- () Check coolant level
- () Check and make sure sea strainer is cleared out
- () Start gen and check for leaks
- () Check a/c panel and make sure all systems work with gen
- () Check shore power cord and connection for proper connection
- () Check boat system with shorepower plugged in and turned on
